For places in constant change, in transition, sustainability does not only mean declining the internationally agreed Sustainable Development Goals on an urban level. It means the ability to engage the different levels of governance in dialogue, to listen to experts, to reflect by paying attention to those who have conceived and continue to act sharing the principles and goals of the 2030 Agenda. It also means considering not only nations, but also including territories, metropolitan and urban units with their socio-economic and demographic dimensions.

In order to develop an integrated reflection between theory, empirical evidence and policy suggestions, the Fondazione Eni Enrico Mattei in the framework of the Milano Digital Week is organising a workshop with the participation of international institutions, national public institutions and change actors committed to the territory.

The event is also an opportunity to present the third update of the SDSN Italia SDGs City Index developed by FEEM, the first urban sustainability index linked to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.

It will be followed by a round table that will bring together the key players in the transition towards Sustainable Local Development: public administration, private sector, universities, associations and research.
